# Conclusion

- 1. Photo-lithography have to use low-k1 process to delineate 45nmhp or 32nmhp patterns, and it causes several problems such as lack of CD control and cost.
- 2. Mask cost is increasing rapidly in photo-lithography due to the use of complicated OPC, and it will be a serious problem especially for ASIC business in hp45nm and hp32nm nodes.
- 3. EUVL can easily delineate 45nmhp and 32nmhp patterns using simple process, and therefore it is superior in CD control as well as cost.
